Included in this program: Domine, Ad Adjuvandum Me Festina by baroque composer G.B. Martini; G.F. Handel's Coronation Anthem No. 4; Felix Mendelssohn's Hear My Prayer; and music by Paul Winter Consort composer Paul Halley, including "The Rain is Over and Gone," "Ubi Caritas" and "Freedom Trilogy." This concert of joyous music that includes spirited baroque masterpieces, beautiful romantic melodies and harmonies, and contemporary music that combines chant, traditional tunes, gospel, and African melodies and rhythms promises to be both entertaining and inspirational.

Welcome to the Genesee Valley Orchestra and Chorus's 38th year of bringing a wondrous variety of music to the Greater Rochester community. In 1976, as part of Fairport's celebration of our nation's bicentennial, Virginia Hogan was asked to get a community group together to sing patriotic songs on the Erie Canal. This small group of singers has evolved into the GVOC of today: an orchestra and 65 singers. GVOC members are your friends and neighbors who would like to share their love of music with you.

Our first concert will be held on December 6 and 7 and is entitled: ***A Christmas Garland***--beautiful music which, when strung together, will be a wonderful way to start this season of love and hope. This concert will include Bach's well-known cantata "Wachet Auf" based on the hymn "Sleepers Awake" by Phillipp Nicolai. **BROTHER HEINRICH'S CHRISTMAS**, by John Rutter, is a fable with narrator, choir and small orchestra and is a story of a medieval monk who is having difficulty coming up with a new song for the visiting Archbishop and the surprising end to his story. **TWO CHRISTMAS SPIRITUALS**, arranged by Robert Scandrett, will include the beautiful "Mary had a Baby" and "Rise Up Shepherd". **A CHRISTMAS GARLAND** by Conrad Susa is a creative blend of many beloved carols, ending in a triumphant finale of "Joy to the World".

Our March 9 concert will be our popular dinner concert, with silent auction, at EagleVale Golf Club and is entitled: ***All Creatures Great and Small: A Musical Menagerie***. This promises to be a delightful evening paying tribute to all our animal friends who provide us with great joy and entertainment.

The June 7th concert, ***Strength, Hope, Grace*** (words many of us try to live our lives by) will conclude GVOC's musical season. From baroque to contemporary, this music of acclaimed composers and arrangers will be not only entertaining, but inspirational.
